It Sheweth the sayd &c. to all manner of printers booke sellers and other one officers ministers
and subiects greeting. - So do you to understande that of our grace especiallly we have v v
granted this your privilege and licence and by these presents do grant and give privilege
and licence to our Belovied subiect John Daye of our Citie of London printer unto his
factours and assignes to print or cause to be printed at Westm' at Cathedraline in English
Shirke we have caused to be set forth for the better instruction of youth to be taught
in English Scholes having the remembrance of the ABC. With the brief Cathedraline they
printed any other privilege or licence to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding and also we
give like privilege and licence to the said John Daye his factours and assignes to have the v v
printing and reprinting of all such Sermons and bookes devised and compiled by the right reverend
father in god John nose bisshop of Exeter or by Thomas Secroide professor of Divinitie as v v
hereafter shall be at his costes and charge and by his payement set forth and made. So that
no such booke nor any parte of them be in any wise repugnant to the holy Scriptures or
preaching in religion and the lawes of our Realme. And furthermore one plecture is that
the same John Daye his factours and assignes shall and may have thonly printing from
time to time of the same Cathedralines and other booke as before is declared in v v
recompence of his industrie paynes and charges to be sustained in that behalf. Strictly
forbidding by these presents all and singular one subiect at Westm' printers or booke sell
as all other persons within our Realmes and dominions whatsoever they be to print or cause
to be printed within any our said dominions the booke aforesaid or any of them but only the
said John Daye and his assignes neither to buy any other sortes of impressions thence such as
shall be printed by the said John Daye and his assignes upon paine of our heigh displeasure
and that every offendour therein shall forfeit to us forty shillings for every such booke or booke at
any time so printed or bought contrary to the true meaning of this our present licence and v v
privilege one and beside all such booke to be forfeited to some one shall susteine the v
charge and sue the said forfeiture in one behalf. Sillying therefore and commanding all our
officers and ministers as they receive our fiat and seal thereto one displeasure and indignation
for the contrary that they and every of them if neede shall require do it and assiste the
aforesaid John Daye his factours and assignes in due executing and execution of this our present
licence and privilege with the effect according to the true meaning of the same. In Statutes
