in consideration of the diligent tudyng and charyges whiche our trustye and welbelovyd counsaill Thomas

englyshe tongue for edyficacion of youthe and honest peccacion of the readers of the same have geveyn and gūnted
and by theis presentes for us and for the heyres and successors of us the saide Quene do geve and gūnto unto
the saide Thomas phayre licence and ppyndge that he and his assignes only and no othe pson or psones
shall howsoever have authority and liberte to print the saide booke or any parte thereof in ppynte and
to sell and vyle the same at all tymes at theyr pleasure during the lyef natyvall of the saide Thomas phayre
and further that it shall not be lawfull for any maner of othe pson or psones of our saide subiectes or of
our heyres or successors to print or prynte to be imprinted the saide booke or anye pte thereof during all
the saide tyme nor any copie or copies of the translation or donges of the saide Thomas whiche the saide
Thomas or his assignes at his or theyr costes and charyges shall fyste ppynte or set furthe during the
tyme of tenne yeres nexte ensuyng the ppyntinge of the same upon payne of forfaiture and confiscacion
of the same booke and bookes and any of them and also of the some of tenne poundes for euy suche
impressyon or sale to be levied and taken to thuse of us and theyres and successors of us the saide
Quene. Wherfore we will and commaunde all you our printere booke selles and othe our subiectes that ye
nor anye of you do presume prynte or attempte to ppynte any of the saide bookes whiche the saide Thomas
or his assignes as aforesaid shall fyste impprynte during the tyme of this our saide ppyndge and licence
or to print to sell anye suche booke or bookes impprynted contrary to this our licence and ppyndge upon the
paynes aforesaid mencioned. And as yet tender our pleasure and will aboyde the contrary. pvided always that
this our saide ppyndge touching ppynting of any othe booke or bookes than the saide booke of Aeneidos
shall not in any wise be prejudicall or hurtfull to anye licence or ppyndge of ppyntinge heretofore
gūnted by us to any othe pson or psones. Witness wherof our selfes at Westmynster
