and bookeller, had by the grant of our late deye brother of Worthie memorie King Edward the Sixt licence to
printe all maner of primers that then were and from thenforth should be set forth agreeable to the booke of
Common prayer at the same tyme established And in the tyme of our late deye Brother Edward the Sixt had not
onlye defeated theif to his great losse but with also unpoynted long tyme and deppred of gret multitude of the
said primers and also of other great nombre of booke which tended to his vtter vtter vntill he was pleased to give
and graunte and by these pntes for vs our heires and Successours so of our speciall grace moe motion and a
certeyn knowledge yve and graunte full power and authorite pmylledge and licence vnto our said loving
Subject Sillis Reges and to his assignes for this during the tyme of his naturall life to impinte or cause to
be impinted and seth all maner of booke of private prayer psalterie and commonie called or taken for primer also
of psalterie both in grete volumes and small in latine or englyshe which now be or at any tyme hereafter shall
set forth and printed by vs our heires and Successours or by any other person that is authorized by vs to be
hadde read and taught of our loving Subject thoroughout all our Realmes and Dominiones during the said
tyme of his naturall life any other pmylledge or any other order heretofore graunted or taken to the contrary in
notwithstanding Strayghthe inhibiting and forbidding all other our Subjecte to printe vtter or sell or cause
to be printed vttered or sold any other booke or booke of private prayer primer or psalterie than such as shall
by the said Sillis Reges or his assignes printed or caused to be printed according to the true meaning of this
our present pmylledge upon paine of forfaiture of all such booke as they shall impinte vtter or sell contrary
to the meaning hereof - Wherfor we will and commaunde all our officers and Subjecte as they tender our favour
and with theyre our displeasur that they and every of them if neede requyre do ayde and assist the said Sillis
Reges and his assignes in the due execution of this our licence - In witness hereof re. Witness our self at
